**Action Taken Report**

**Introduction:**

The College notified the Students to submit online students' satisfaction survey within the stipulated period. The students were given online link on the Whatsapp group and e-mail. They were given a questionnaire of 24 questions related to the overall performance and infrastructure of the institution. There were 266 students reported their responses on the performance of the institution out of 511 students. As per survey, the following common suggestions were given by the students-

**Area of action to be taken:**

1	Need to arrange more English speaking sessions for students
2	Library services need to be improved
3	Need to plan more visits to nearby industries and local business firms
4	Need to plan more doubt sessions and assignments
5	Need to arrange more ICT sessions in teaching – learning process

**Steps to be taken for improvement:**

As per responses given by the students, 81.6 % students were satisfied and happy to the questions asked in the survey. The suggestion related to office, sport department and library were given by the students. On the basis of students suggestion the institution management had taken action as follow-

1. The principal, Dr. Sunil Helkar informed the Department of English to plan and execute more English speaking sessions during the Spoken English Course.
2. As per suggestion given, the principal called the meeting of Library Committee and instructed to improve overall library services.



3. The Principal, Dr. S. D. Helkar informed the Department of Commerce and Geography to plan visits to local industries and business firms.
4. The principal discussed and instructed the teaching staff to plan more doubt sessions and assignments for the students in the staff meet.
5. The principal instructed the staff to use more ICT sessions in teaching – learning process.

**Outcome:**

1. The Department of English arranged extra sessions of speaking sessions during Spoken English Course and TCS training course. Twenty seven students learned to communicate in English more effectively.
2. The library arranged more access of books for the students who were preparing for competitive examinations.
3. The department of Commerce and Geography planned study and survey tour to RDL Industry Ltd. Chincholi.
4. The teaching faculty planned and executed more interactive sessions and home assignments for the students during the teaching and off the teaching hours. The teachers arranged interactive and doubt sessions for the students in the classroom.
5. All the departments arranged more ICT sessions such as PPT, audio-visual, online meet and film screening etc.
